Happy New Year!

This month will be a busy one for the children. In addition to discussing the winter season and its activities and characteristics, we will start a unit on the solar system. As we blast off into 2018, we will take the children on an imaginary voyage through space. We will visit each planet, the moon, and some of the constellations and then make a special return trip to Mother Earth.

We will practice recognition, printing, and sounds of the letters Ss, Tt, Uu and Vv through hands-on games, papers, and workbook activities. We will continue copying words to practice letter formation.

In math, we will continue to concentrate on the recognition and printing of the numerals 11-20. The children will continue to practice counting as high as 31 to include all of January's days. We will also continue working with the order of items (1st, 2nd, and 3rd).

We will be working on helping the children learn their phone number and address. Please review this at home since they will need to know this for kindergarten.



After evaluating each child individually, we will send home a progress report home on January 19.

For the safety of the children, please load your children into the car from the sidewalk and passenger's side rather than from the driver's side of the car, and be sure and buckle up.

In our extended day this month, we will focus on measuring, volume, length and mass. We will also continue our unit about Space in the afternoon class.
