We are so pleased with the progress your children have made in the first half of the school year. They have adjusted well. The holiday break may have some children apprehensive about returning to school.

In January, we will continue to have the children cut, color, paint, and do other activities to help develop their fine motor skills. We will concentrate on having them try to copy their names. Some of the children are already trying to do this. We will provide practice for those who can and guidance for those who are still working on letter formation and order. While reviewing A-K, we will introduce L,M,N,O and P. We will provide opportunities to recognize and form each letter. Many games and activities we do emphasize letter recognition. The children are following along very well. They get especially excited when the letter of the day is in their name.

We will review 1-6, and circle, square, triangle, and rectangle. We will continue to emphasize sharing and being kind to school friends and using good school manners and words.

We will be doing a general evaluation of your child's skills this month and will recommend who would do best in the:

4-year old 3 day program for children who will potentially be going on to Kindergarten the following year and whose skills are more developed.

3 Day Enrichment Program half day or full day- for children who will be going on to Kindergarten the following year and whose skills are well developed.

Placement also depends on your child's maturity level and when they will definitely be old enough to start kindergarten. Most school districts will require the child to be 5 by September 1 of that school year. Both the 4 year-old 3 day program and the Enrichment programs will prepare your child for kindergarten. Remember, you are welcome to come observe both the 4 year old and Enrichment classes in January.

Please check the extra clothes in your child's back pack and make sure they are the correct size. (Just in case there is an accident).
