We hope everyone has a joyous and peaceful holiday season. January is a good time to remind you that all children are different and their level of achievement will not be the same. Our goal is to present this material and to have each child take as much from it as he/she is

ready to receive without feeling frustrated. A good self-image and attitude toward school is much more important than being forced to learn things when a child is not ready. Our main objective is to prepare children for Kindergarten.

Progress reports will be issued by January 18, 2017.

We will continue to practice recognizing, printing, and sounding out the letters using our worksheets and workbook activities. This month we will be working on the letters **Gg, Qq, Pp, Bb, and Rr,**

In math, we will be recognizing and tracing the numerals 6, 7 and 8, identifying sets of six, seven and eight, and writing the number words.

We will begin January with some "chilly and snowy" art projects.

Please continue to have your child practice putting on his/her coat and practice zipping, snapping and buttoning, too!

Our science interest area, dinosaurs, is a favorite with the children. We will be learning the names of the different dinosaurs and reading library books to learn more about them. We will be making our own "herds of dinosaurs" and making fossils.
