We are all aware of the public health concerns generated by the outbreak of the flu in the United States. It has been heavily covered in the news. We are doing many things here to prevent the spread here at the preschool. Including washing hands frequently, encouraging children to use a tissue and cough into their elbow when sneezing and coughing. We also are washing down toys and cleaning common surfaces. - **Have a fever (your child should be fever free, without Tylenol, for 24 hours.)**
- **Are beginning a cold**
- **Are coughing and sneezing**
- **Have vomited or had diarrhea that morning or the evening before.**

Please notify the school office whenever your child has a contagious illness.
