Note Concerning Enrollment For Next Year

If you have a child registered for one of our 3, 4 or 5-year-old programs for the 2018-2019 school year, the first tuition payment is due on May 14. This money is refundable until August 1. You will receive a payment coupon in mid-April. The payments are as follows: 2-day 3Year Old-classes (\$130-includes Stretch and Learn Program), 3-day 4 year old classes (\$160), 3 day Enrichment class (\$160), 4-day Enrichment class (\$180),

Extended 3 Day Enrichment (9am-3pm) \$320(includes Special Music, Earth Explorers and Gym)

Special Music (\$30) Earth Explorers (\$30) and Kids in the Kitchen (\$30 for 2 sessions a month)

June 4-8 **Play With Your Food** – Do What!? Yes, Paint with pudding, Dance with seeds and raisins and so much more!

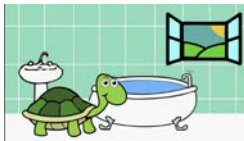
July 9-13 **Around the World-** Hop on our **imaginary** plane and take a trip around the world! Discover how different people live and the land that surrounds them.
