



COVID-19 and Delta Variant DECISION TREE

STAFF PROTOCOL

WHAT TO DO IF A STUDENT IS SICK?

Student is exhibiting symptoms consistent with COVID-19 or the Delta Variant

Student is sick, but symptoms exhibited are not consistent with COVID-19 or the Delta Variant

Student follows protocol consistent with attendance policy

- Student is sent to the Director immediately and Isolated
- Parents are notified to pick up student ASAP
- Parents are to seek medical attention
- Parents are to contact Director with results

The Student is DIAGNOSED/CONFIRMED with COVID-19 or the Delta Variant

Student is NOT diagnosed with COVID -19 or the Delta Variant

Student Must

- Stay home, self-isolate
- Seek medical attention
- Remain home until:
 - At least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared, AND remain fever free for at least 24 hours.
 - Other symptoms have improved.
- Preschool may require clearance from healthcare provider to return.

School Must

- Follow established communication plan to notify staff, students and families.
- Notify the Allegheny County Health Dept.
- Investigate, contact trace, and establish what students and/or staff were in close, unmasked, contact with the sick student.

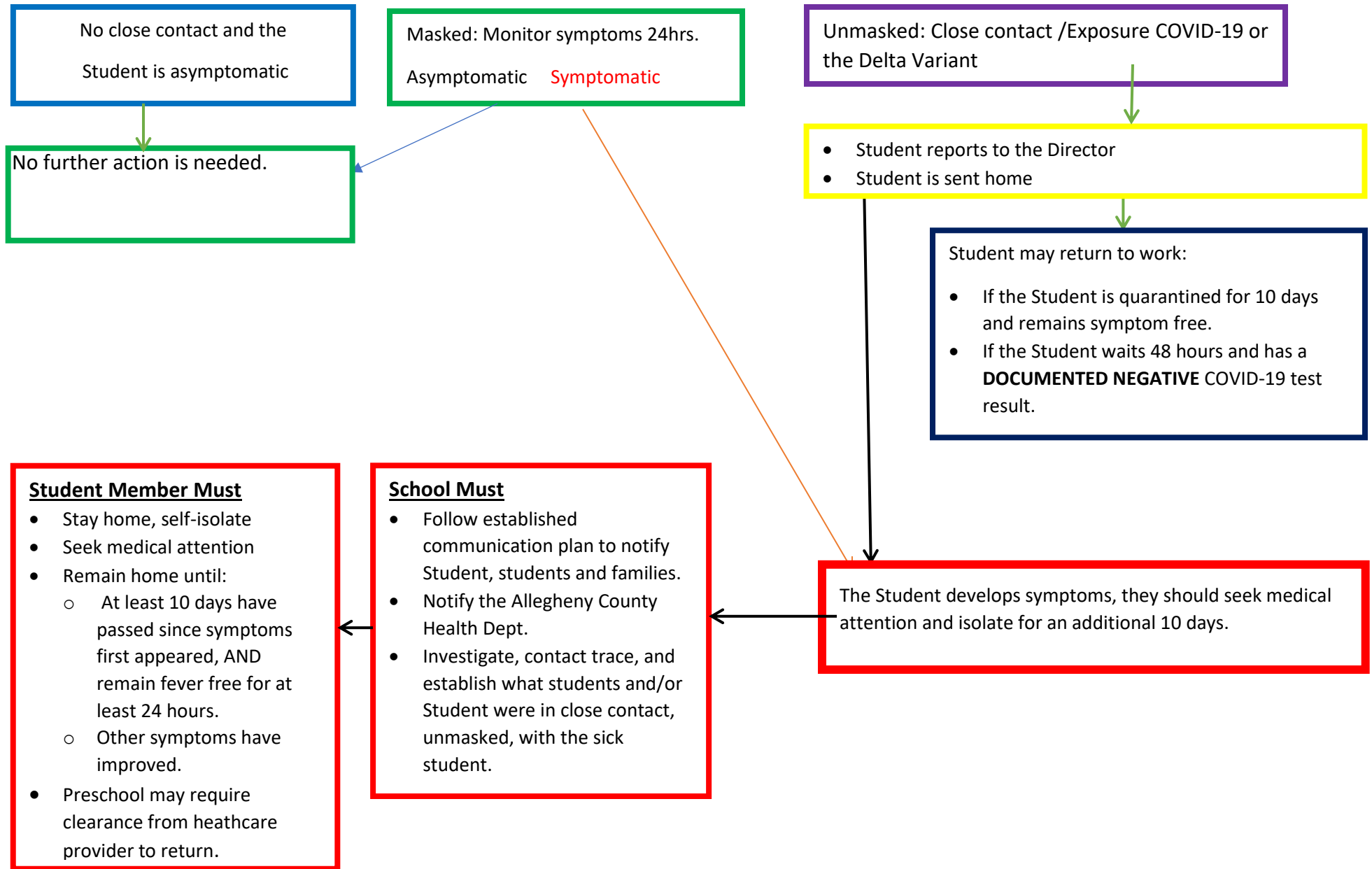
Student Must

- Stay home and remain symptom free for at least 24 hours. (defined as resolution of fever without the use of fever reducing medications.
- AND other symptoms have improved.

School Must

- Clean and ventilate the area(s) where the student was present.

WHAT TO DO IF A STUDENT HAD CONTACT WITH A CONFIRMED CASE COVID-19 or the Delta Variant



WHAT TO DO IF A STAFF MEMBER IS SICK?

Staff member is sick, but symptoms exhibited are not consistent with COVID-19 or the Delta Variant

Staff member is exhibiting symptoms consistent with COVID-19 or Delta variant

Staff member follows protocol consistent with attendance policy

- Staff member reports to the Director
- Staff member is sent home.
- Staff member is to seek medical attention.
- Staff member should make the Director aware of diagnosis and follow direction of health care provider.

The Staff member is DIAGNOSED/CONFIRMED with COVID-19 or Delta Variant

Staff member is NOT diagnosed with COVID -19 or Delta Variant

Staff Member Must

- Stay home, self-isolate
- Seek medical attention
- Remain home until:
 - At least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared AND remain fever free for at least 24 hours.
 - Other symptoms have improved.
- Employer may require clearance from healthcare provider to return.

School Must

- Follow established communication plan to notify staff, students and families.
- Notify the Allegheny County Health Dept.
- Investigate, contact trace, and establish what students and/or staff were in close, unmasked contact with the sick student.

Staff Member Must

- Stay home and remain fever free for at least 24hours. (Defined as resolution of fever without the use of fever reducing medications.
- AND other symptoms have improved.

School Must

- Clean and ventilate the area(s) where the staff member was present.

WHAT TO DO IF A STAFF MEMBER HAD CONTACT WITH A CONFIRMED CASE COVID-19 or Delta Variant

No close contact and the staff member is asymptomatic

Masked: Monitor symptoms 24hrs.
Asymptomatic **Symptomatic**

Unmasked Close contact /Exposure COVID-19 or Delta Variant

No further action is needed.

- Staff member reports to the Director
- Staff member is sent home

Staff may return to work:

- If the staff member is quarantined for 10 days and remains symptom free.
- If the staff member waits 48 hours and has a **DOCUMENTED NEGATIVE** COVID-19 test result.

Staff Member Must

- Stay home, self-isolate
- Seek medical attention
- Remain home until:
 - At least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared, AND remain fever free for at least 24 hours.
 - Other symptoms have improved.
- Employer may require clearance from healthcare provider to return.

School Must

- Follow established communication plan to notify staff, students and families.
- Notify the Allegheny County Health Dept.
- Investigate, contact trace, and establish what students and/or staff were in close, unmasked contact with the sick student.

The Staff member Develops symptoms, they should seek medical attention and isolate for an additional 10 days.
