



2022-23 Covid Policy Addendum

On 8/23/22 this addendum is recommended and approved for the school year of 2022-23 and is subject to change should CDC requirements change, or it is determined that a beneficial change is necessary for the good of the school and the students in attendance.

Positive Covid Test

- If a student tests positive for preschool, they must stay home for a minimum of 5 day.
- If symptoms continue after day 5, they must stay home.
- If symptom have cleared after the 5th day they may return and remain masked for the next 5 days

Exposure in the Community

- No quarantine time.
- Student can return with a mask for 5 days
- On the 5th day test.
- If negative, mask 5 more days
- If positive, then follow procedures for positive test.

Exposure in the residence

- If a family member tests positive. The child must remain home for the next 5 days
- On day 5 they will need to test.
- If negative they can return wearing a mask for the next 10 days.
- If symptoms appear, then follow procedures for positive test.
